

## MEMORANDUM

to

WE, as part of the Boer-Afrikaner people who are being forced against our will into the current political dispensation in South-Africa, declare as follows:

1.

The ANC constantly alleges with fanfare that it always campaigned for- and now rules a democratic state where all human rights are enshrined. Nevertheless, the ANC exercises despotic rule over a certain section of the population – people whose very right to live is attacked by the ANC. We Boer-Afrikaners constitute that section of the South African population.

2.

South-Africa might superficially look like a democracy, but factually we find ourselves in a dictatorship: As Boer-Afrikaners, our numbers can not exercise the slightest influence on whom we are governed by, nor on any of the policies according to which we are governed. Amidst this condition of political oppression, the ANC explicitly calls on its supporters to kill us. When Julius Malema chanted “Kill the Boer”, the ANC fully supported him and even closed ranks with him in Court. We do not fail to get the message: The ANC, as the ruling party in this country, wants us dead. This must necessarily have effect and lead to yet more murders, such as we have had in Delmas when a helpless baby and an elderly

woman were strangled to death on the 23rd of May 2012. One can cite thousands of similar examples, AND WE HAVE HAD ENOUGH of this genocide.

3.

We do not blame the South African Police Service in general or bad policing work for the killings of our people. It is impossible for the Police to protect people who are regularly demonized in the media and declared fair game by nothing less than the ruling party of the state. Therefor, amongst others, we reached cross-roads; we are finished with ANC-ruled South Africa.

We know our rights in terms of International Law. We know the ANC can not stay in breach of our internationally-recognised right to self-determination. We know the ANC can not force us to remain third class citizens against our will in some form of political rape. THEREFOR WE DEMAND THAT GOVERNMENT COMPLIES WITH OUR RIGHT TO SELF-DETERMINATION - WE DEMAND OUR OWN STATE.

In 2011, the VVK facilitated the democratic election of a Boer-Afrikaner Volksraad. This Volksraad twice invited Government and the ANC for discussions, so that a peaceful settlement to our claim of an own state can be negotiated. Up to now, neither of these invitations were replied upon. The door, for now, is still open. However, if the invitation to negotiate with our elected representatives, being the Volksraad, continue to be ignored, we will rightfully take it that the ANC-leadership is not interested in a peaceful settlement of our legitimate claim for self-determination. Let the ANC be assured: That will not be the end of this problem. That will be the beginning of a different phase of our struggle.
